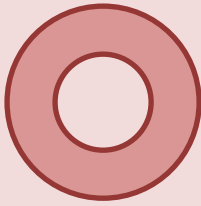

Play Knots and Crosses or Animal Snap. Who will win??

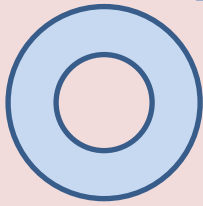
Can your child name all the animals? Can they say the noises they make? Have fun!

Play decorating the cup-cakes and the Sprinkles Game.

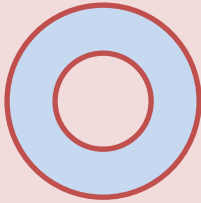
Learn counting. Have fun!

Please enjoy being busy with your child, learning new things and playing together.

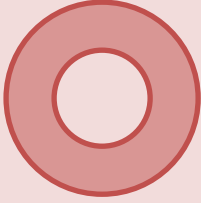

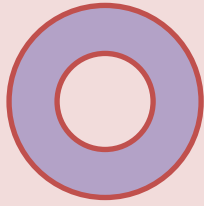
Busy Bag 4: Bath Time

Please enjoy being busy with your child, learning new things and playing together. This Busy Bag is a Story Sack.

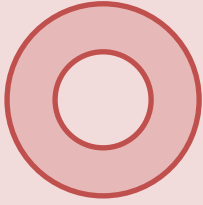
Can one of your toys be the Daddy Bear or Goldilocks?

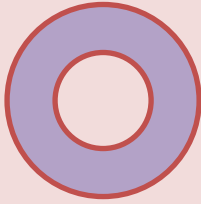
Play Dominoes with your family. Who will win?

Please enjoy being busy with your child, learning new things and playing together.

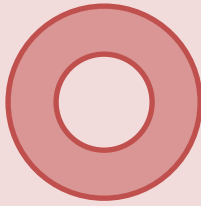
Learn how to thread and make patterns or necklaces or friendship bracelets. Who will you give yours to?

Please enjoy being busy with your child, learning new things and playing together.

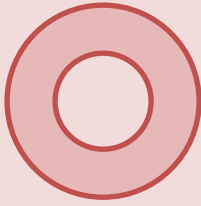
Play at cooking. Cook your own dinners- mix and mash things from the garden or kitchen. Or follow our Coloured Spaghetti recipe. Bon Appetito!

Please enjoy being busy with your child, learning Story Sack.

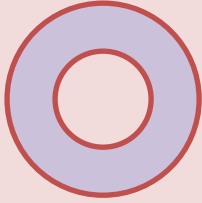
Can you make a house for one of the three pigs? Can you huff and puff like a wolf? What did you blow down?

Please enjoy being busy with your child, learning new things and playing together.

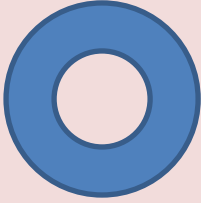
Learn to cut and stick a house. Use the stencils to write the number or name of your house. Or just for fun.

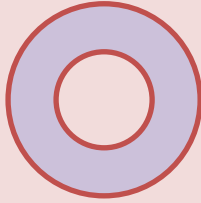
Learn to match. What will you make with the straws and fuzzy sticks?

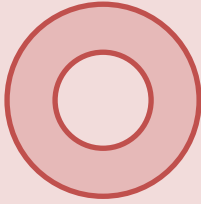
Cover your carpet or table with jigsaw pictures! Did you manage the big one?

Wooden Spoon Puppet

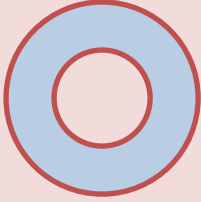
