

Do you know your Health and Safety Signs?

It's important to know what health and safety signs mean if you are to stay safe in the workplace. Try this quick quiz to find out how much you already know about health and safety signs and learn more about the signs that are new to you.

Red signs mean 'do not' or 'no' - such as do not smoke or no fork lift trucks.

Yellow gives a warning - beware of moving vehicles or warning, high voltage.

Blue means 'do this for your own good' - wash your hands, wear safety footwear, hard hats must be worn or wear safety goggles.
